- ICANN is an organisation that manages the distribution of, and the development of technical policy relating to, domain names and numbers (IP addresses).
- Domain names and IP addresses connect people to the internet

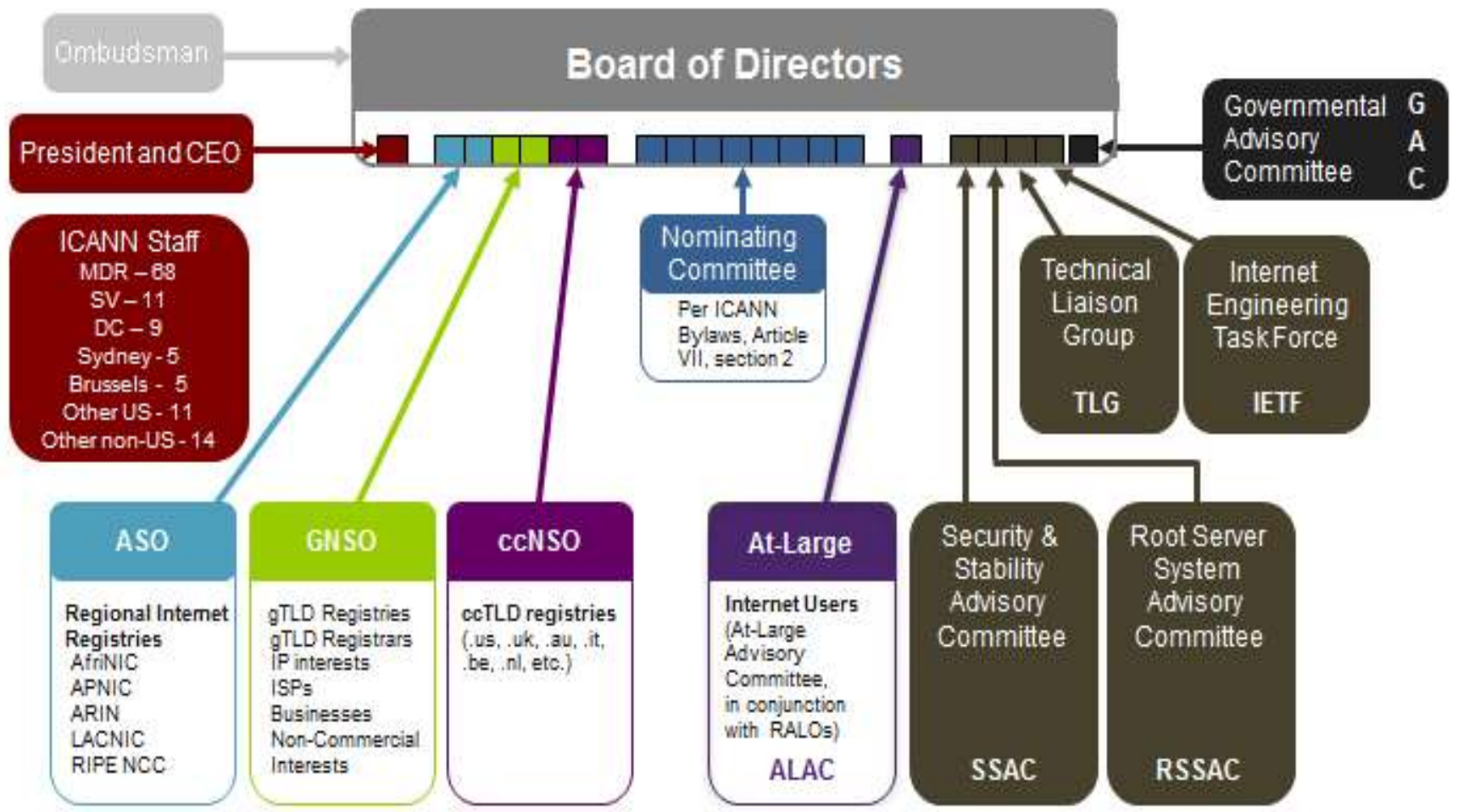
So what does the ALAC do?



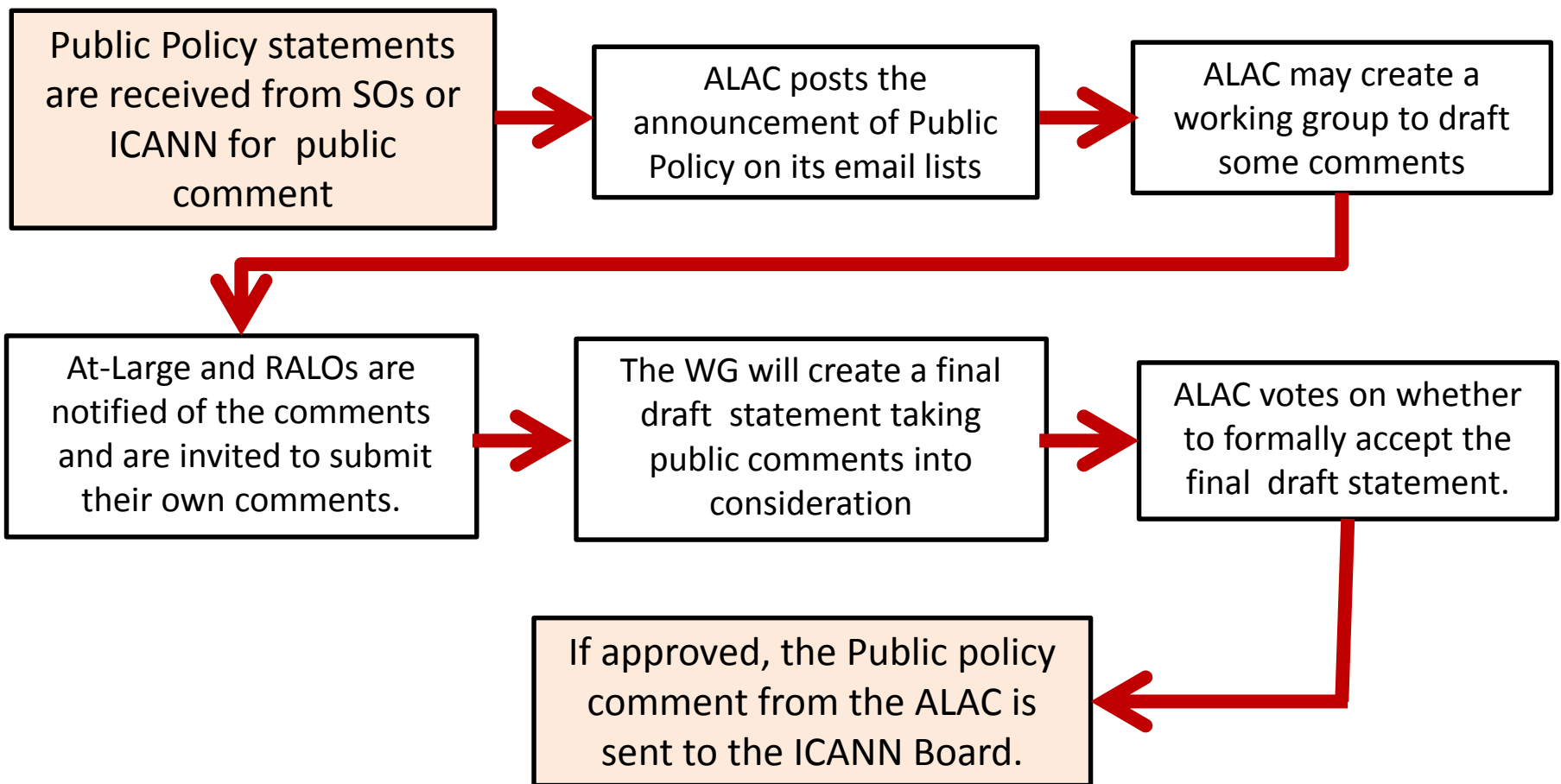
The role of ALAC

At-Large in ICANN



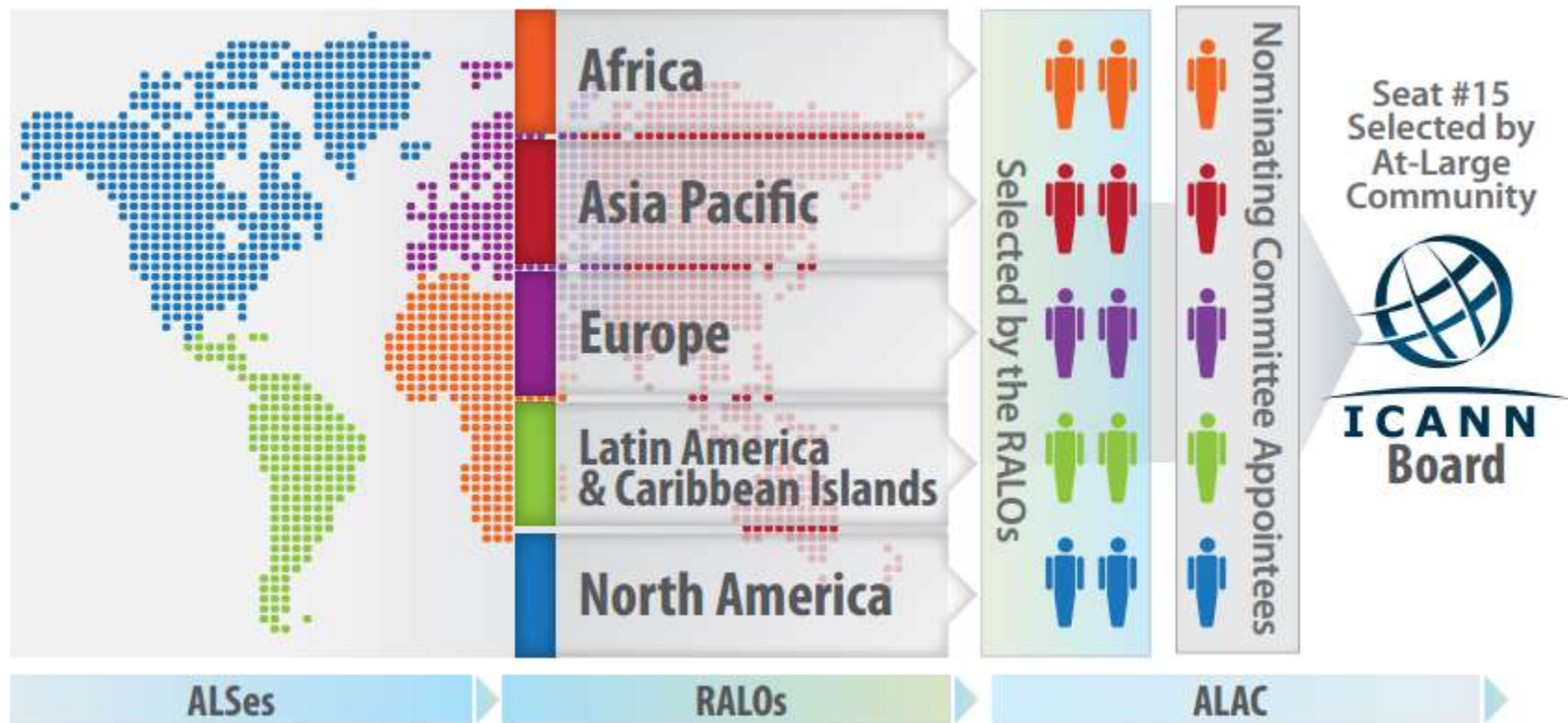
ALAC Policy Development Process
